# EMERSON ROSE ACT

In 2013, the ERHF worked with the South Carolina legislature and Governor Nikki Haley in passing the Emerson Rose Act. Since that time, over 500,000 South Carolina newborns have received this noninvasive, life-saving test for undetected heart defects prior to discharge from the hospital. Studies have since shown a 33% decrease in death due to critical congenital heart defects in states with this screening in place.









## ABOUTCHDS

- A congenital heart defect (CHD) is a structural abnormality in the heart that is present at birth.
- Approximately 44,000 children (1 out of every 100) are born with a CHD every year in the USA.
- CHDs are the most common birth defect: one baby is born with a CHD every 15 minutes in the USA.
